TEBALDI – GIGLI – CORELLI LYRIC COMPETITION

1st INTERNATIONAL OPERA SINGING COMPETITION IN THE MARCHE REGION

Consorzio Marche Spettacolo (CMS) is pleased to announce the 1st edition of the International Opera Singing Competition in Pesaro, organized by the Marche Regional Authority in collaboration with CMS, the Municipality of Pesaro and Pesaro 2024 - Italian Capital of Culture.

The competition will be led by a prime jury composed of the most relevant personalities representing the main Opera producers or promoters in the Marche region, with the chairmanship of the Superintendent and Artistic Director of Teatro alla Scala in Milan, Dominique Meyer.

The competition will take place in Pesaro from March 12th to March 17th 2024.

The deadline for submitting the applications is set on 15th February 2024.

1) ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The competition is open to opera singers of all vocal registers and nationalities. For female singers the age limit will be 32 years old, they must be born after 1992. For male singers the age limit will be 36 years old, they must be born after 1987.

2-3) REGISTRATION METHODS, DOCUMENTS TO ATTACH AND APPLICATION FEE

All candidates must send the following documents to the competition's secretary office via e-mail (segreteria@marchespettacolo.it) no later than 15th February 2024:

- 1. a copy of your ID or passport;
- 2. a recent picture of yourself;
- 3. a brief curriculum vitae (in Italian or English);

4. 2 videos of performances displaying opera arias (with no repertoire limitations) by two different

authors. The videos must be uploaded on YouTube in unlisted mode (no WeTransfer) specifying

the recording date and piano accompanist or the orchestra.

The files must be live and not subjected to post-production. Only full clean sound and good

visibility are recommended of the candidate.

5. a scanned copy of the receipt showing the payment of the pre-selection fee € 80, made by bank

transfer. The candidate must pay any extra transmission costs. The bank transfer should be

issued to the account of Consorzio Marche Spettacolo, indicating the name and surname of the

candidate followed by "Concorso Lirico Tebaldi-Gigli-Corelli".

All the documents must be sent in digital format via email to segreteria@marchespettacolo.it,

no later than 15th February 2024.

The application will NOT be taken into consideration if, on the deadline date of registration, the

competitor has not sent the copy of the payment of the registration fee. The competitor must

ensure the regularity of his registration, in case of failure to receive the registration confirmation.

No reimbursement of expenses of any kind will be paid to candidates. In case of failure to

participate in the Competition, the secretariat is not required, in any case, to the reimbursement of the registration fee, except in the case of cancellation of the Competition for the responsibility of the organization.

There are no scholarships or benefits available.

Candidates, citizens of non-EU countries, must perform to the organizational secretariat, under penalty of exclusion from the competition, a suitable qualification entry into the territory of the Italian Republic, as foreseen by current legislation.

There are no limitations for accepting applications. Admission to the selection tests will be subject to acceptance and compliance with all the provisions contained in this notice and is ad unquestionable judgment of the examining commission.

Competitors are invited to consult the Consorzio Marche Spettacolo website, https://marchespettacolo.com/, to view the list of admitted candidates, which will be announced by 23rd February 2024.

4) PROGRAMME (FOR THOSE PASSING THE PRE-SELECTIONS)

The selection tests will be held in Pesaro at the Rossini Theater as part of the overall program of 'Pesaro, Italian capital of culture for the year 2024'; the tests will be open to those who pass the pre-selection video; will take place from 12 to 15 March 2024 through the following phases: elimination round, semi-final round and final round.

Candidates must present six opera arias, to be performed by heart in key e original languages, complete with recitative and/or cabaletta (when provided); at least two must be chosen from the list of compulsory arias (8).

The complete list of all songs for pre-selections and selections must be inserted in the body text

of the registration email. Candidates admitted must bring along all the vocal/piano arrangements of the pieces indicated in the programme presented.

The programme:

· <u>Elimination Round</u>: **Tuesday 12th and Wednesday 13th March 2024** (morning and afternoon) at Teatro G. Rossini in Pesaro.

Each candidate will perform two arias, one of their choice, and the other chosen by the Jury from those indicated in the programme presented, with a piano accompaniment. The Selection Board reserves the right to limit the hearing to a single passage.

· Semi-final: Thursday 14th March 2024 at Teatro G. Rossini in Pesaro.

Each candidate will perform two arias chosen by the Jury from those included in the programme presented and that have not been performed during the elimination round, with the accompaniment of a pianist.

· Final: Friday 15th March 2024 at Teatro G. Rossini in Pesaro.

Each candidate will perform, with the accompaniment of a pianist, two arias chosen by the Jury from the six indicated in the programme they presented. This performance will take place in front of an audience. At the end of the final, the jury will vote and the winners will be announced right after. The winners of the Competition will perform in a concert at the "G.Rossini" Theater in Pesaro, accompanied by the FORM Orchestra - Fondazione Orchestra Regionale delle Marche, on **Sunday 17th March 2024** at 9.00 pm, free admission.

· Rehearsal with the Orchestra: Saturday 16th March 2024 the finalists will rehearse with the Orchestra FORM — Orchestra Filarmonica Marchigiana. The rehearsal schedule will be communicated directly to the winners.

5) PRIZES

First Prize: € 10.000 (ten thousand)

Second Prize: € 5.000 (five thousand)

Third Prize: € 3.000 (three thousand)

The jury reserves the right to propose contracts and auditions to the candidates of their liking.

6) PIANO ACCOMPANIST

Consorzio Marche Spettacolo will provide two pianists to accompany each candidate. It will not

be possible to have a personal pianist. Each candidate will have the opportunity to rehearse with

the pianist one hour before their audition for a time equivalent to that of the hearing.
